- A non-European society that provides contrasts with British history



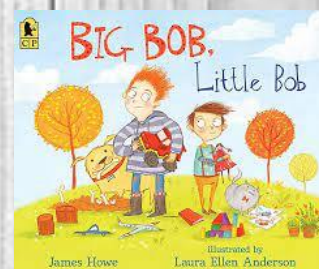
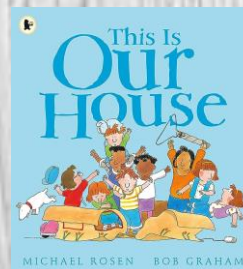
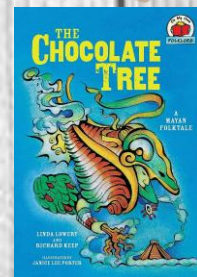
## The Arts
